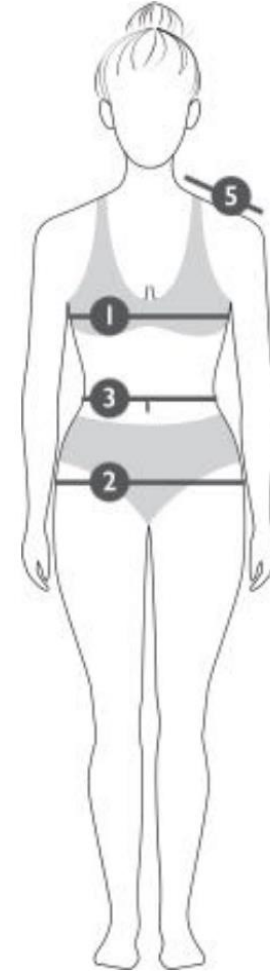
HOW TO MEASURE TERESA ATELIER GOWNS

To avoid any fit issues for your brides, please ensure you follow this measuring guide, carefully. Below are the three main measurement points required to determine your brides correct sizing

1. Bust

Measure around the body ensuring the tape measure is over the fullest part of the bust, with the arms relaxed and hanging by the side, If your bride does not plan on wearing a bra with her gown, ensure you measure the bust without a bra, Alternatively, if your bride plans on wearing a bra, measure the bust with this bra on, or a bra with a similar amount of padding.



2. HIP

Measure around the body ensuring the tape measure is over the widest part of the hips. Note: this is quite commonly below the hip bones and can even be down around the lower bottom. Every body shape is unique. This is most important for fitted gowns.

3. WAIST

Measure around the body ensuring the tape measure is sitting in the smallest part of the waist. Ensure your bride is relaxed when you are measuring the waist and is not tensing in any way.

*Please allow for an up to 2 shade dye-lot difference from original sample

*Please allow for a +/- 1/2 inch production tolerance

*Hollow to hem is 60 inches, skirt length is 47 inches from natural waist
